

RSVP Cards from \$1.25



This card is sent with your invitation, with the date of reply specified, which is usually 4-6 weeks before your wedding.

RSVPs confirm numbers and details for any additional items you may require for the reception, such as Place cards / Seating plans / Menu's / Bonbonniere, so please consider this when setting your RSVP date.

They also help to keep the invitation wording short but sweet as the relevant information is printed on the RSVP.

The guests complete the names of all invitees that are attending / or unable to attend.

You don't generally pre-print their names on the RSVP as not all persons invited may be able to attend.

A plain white envelope is included. Pre-printed envelopes however are a nice addition.

It's also a great idea to ask guests to include any special dietary requirements on their RSVP. If you are providing transport this information should be included on the guest information card but you may wish to ask for numbers requiring the bus or transportation on the RSVP.

Most of us like to take advantage of family and friends being together and usually arrange a breakfast or barbeque lunch the day after the ceremony - why not include an 'After I Do Barbeque card' with all the details so that guests can plan around this regarding accommodation and departure times. The RSVP can be modified to include attendance at this event too, which will also assist you with catering.



\$1.25 Flat card style printed on light-medium cardstock. Sizes are made to suit approx. 14cm x 8.5cm, 10cm x 14.5cm, 13cm square.

Additional Options—Cover:

\$0.50: Per feature – some may cost more than \$0.50 eg contrast backing is \$1.00

\$1.00: Lace cut overlay

\$2.00: Belly band with name feature (if grouping a number of flat cards together)

Features include:

Printed border or feature, embossed or decorative paper, ribbon, adhesive beads, contrasting coloured strip / scalloped border, buckle (is \$1.00)
